

WHEREAS, by the terms of chapter two hundred and thirty (230) of the General Laws of 1887, the Secretary of State is authorized and empowered to contract with the West Publishing Company for the continuance of the publication of the Minnesota Reports for eight (8) years from the termination of the existing contract between the State and said Company,

Therefore, pursuant to said chapter 230 of the General Laws of 1887, it is agreed this 8th day of April A.D. 1889, by and between the West Publishing Company and the State of Minnesota that the annexed contract shall be and the same is hereby renewed for the period of eight (8) years in addition to the time therein provided for, and the said contract is <sup>in</sup> all respects, matters and things continued in force with the same force and effect as though the same had been this day redrafted and reexecuted; provided, however, that said contract is modified in this, that the said West Publishing Company in addition to the number of volumes therein provided to be delivered to the State, to deliver one hundred and twenty-five (125) additional copies to the State of volume thirty-two (32) of the Minnesota Reports, and each succeeding volume during said term of eight (8) years, said modification being made pursuant to the provisions of an act of the Legislature of the State of Minnesota for the year 1889, entitled "An act to modify the contract for the publication of the Minnesota Reports," approved March 30th, 1889
