WHEREAS: there are many American citizens of Mexican descent in the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: it has become tradition for them to celebrate Mexico's Independence Anniversary thereby featuring Mexican songs, dances, unique handicrafts, and many other forms of Mexican art expressions; and

WHEREAS: through the years these festivals have attracted favorable public attention, serving as a friendly meeting ground for better social and cultural relations between all citizens in this area;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 9 - 15, 1973 as
