In accordance with the requirements of Section 2 of Chapter 12 of the General Laws of Minnesota, for 1887, we, the undersigned, Robert Harris, President of the Saint Paul and Northern Pacific Railway Company, and George S. Jones, Treasurer of said Company, do hereby specially report and state that the total number of shares of capital stock of said Company, actually issued, to and including the date of this report, is Fifty-four thousand and two (54,002) shares; and that the amount of capital stock issued by said Company during the year last past is Four thousand and two shares, for which there was received, in money, Four hundred thousand two hundred dollars (\$400,200.).
