WHEREAS: The National Association of Air Traffic Specialists is meeting in convention in Minneapolis, Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: nearly 4,000 men and women in the Air Traffic Control Stations labor diligently day and night to provide information leading to safe flight for all our nation's aircraft; and

WHEREAS: the service and knowledge provided by those men and women to their fellow man in flight has not only made for safe flight, but in over 5,000 emergencies each year results in saving untold numbers of lives and vast sums of property; and

WHEREAS: despite tremendous increases in work loads with no increase in numbers, these men and women have continued to meet the demand for services;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Wednesday, September 19, 1973 to be

in Minnesota to recognize the vital role these Specialists play, and to honor especially those Specialists in the Air Traffic Control Stations in Minnesota.
