



Proclamation

WHEREAS: it is the 60th anniversary of the Anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith; and

WHEREAS: the Anti-Defamation League has an inspiring record of participation in the democratic process in the United States; and

WHEREAS: the Anti-Defamation League has, from the beginning, fought to secure equal rights for all minority groups; and

WHEREAS: the Anti-Defamation League and the principles for which it stands are intertwined with the survival of democracy itself;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, October 14, 1973 to be

ANTI-DEFAMATION LEAGUE DAY

in Minnesota.
