



# Proclamation

WHEREAS: the incidence of crime continues to increase in the State of Minnesota and the problem of crime is of growing concern to more and more of our citizens; and

WHEREAS: individual citizens can assist in reducing crime by taking basic security measures to protect their persons and property; and

WHEREAS: increased involvement by citizens in crime prevention activities and increased cooperation between citizens and their law enforcement agencies can help to reduce the incidence of crime in Minnesota;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim September 24, 1973 to October 6, 1973 as

## CRIME PREVENTION TIME

in Minnesota.
