WHEREAS: grandparents play a most significant role in the lives of Americans of all ages, instilling in their children and their children's children the honorable concepts of life; and

WHEREAS: those who have enjoyed the kind affection, special attention and words of wisdom of grandparents realize the valuable contributions made to their lives; and

WHEREAS: special recognition should be made of these highly esteemed people so they will know they are greatly loved and well appreciated; and

WHEREAS: grandparents should be honored with a special day in the same way that mothers and fathers each have their remembrance days;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, October 14, 1973 as

GRANDPARENTS' DAY

in Minnesota and urge all citizens to join in the observance with special recognition of grandparents.
