WHEREAS: Michael P. Hurley's membership in the Brotherhood of Locomotive Engineers, Division 333, spanned 65 years; and

WHEREAS: he is the father of two daughters and is blessed with two grandchildren and 13 great grandchildren; and

WHEREAS: Michael P. Hurley devoted his life to his family and to his job; and

WHEREAS: this devotion afforded Michael P. Hurley the joy and rewards he asked from life; and

WHEREAS: Michael P. Hurley has reached the remarkable age of 100 with grace and dignity;
