WHEREAS: the State of Minnesota has long been acclaimed for its friendly and concerned people; and

WHEREAS: as our nation emerges from a prolonged war and period of internal unrest, it is fitting that Minnesota lead the nation and the world in a concerted effort to bring about a better understanding and appreciation of our fellow man; and

WHEREAS: by initiating a new American tradition for this purpose, we look forward with the hope that this understanding and good will might grow from day to day, neighbor to neighbor, nation to nation and generation to generation; and

WHEREAS: as Governor I urge the people of Minnesota, interested groups and organizations to observe such a day with appropriate ceremonies and activities;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, September 23, 1973 as

NEXT DOOR NEIGHBOR DAY

in Minnesota.
