WHEREAS: Reverend Ronald Terry Sr. is celebrating his sixth anniversary as Pastor of Sabathani Baptist Church; and

WHEREAS: Reverend Terry has labored tirelessly to foster brotherhood and understanding between black and white, young and old, and Catholics and Protestants; and

WHEREAS: his concern for problems of the inner-city and for building Christian love between all people almost cost him his life; and
