- WHEREAS: Dr. Clemens Matthew Granskou, President Emeritus of St. Olaf College, has dedicated his life to the development and enrichment of higher education; and
- WHEREAS: Dr. Granskou's efforts on behalf of St. Olaf College have contributed significantly to its phenomenal growth and to the academic excellence for which the College is recognized; and
- WHEREAS: Dr. Granskou, through his involvement in Christian education in the United States and abroad, has strengthened the relevance and importance of the Christian ethic in modern educational techniques; and
- WHEREAS: the celebration of the one hundredth anniversary of St. Olaf College will begin on Founders' Day, November 6; and
- WHEREAS: the College has chosen this prestigious day on which to honor President Emeritus Clemens Matthew Granskou by giving his name to the St. Olaf Center and Administration building; and
