



Proclamation

WHEREAS: there are girls ages 16 - 21 who are potential dropouts and young women with unmet needs; and

WHEREAS: there are girls who are dropouts without adequate education or skills; and

WHEREAS: there are families who need referral services; and

WHEREAS: Women in Community Service (WICS) come together to work for a common cause in the framework provided by their national organizations; Church Women United, National Council of Catholic Women, National Council of Jewish Women, National Council of Negro Women and American G. I. Forum Auxiliary;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 16, 1973 as

MINNESOTA WICS DAY

and call upon all Minnesotans to help the WICS volunteers work to break the cycle of poverty.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this eighth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-three and of the State the one hundred and fifteenth.
