WHEREAS: potato chips have been part of the American scene since 1853, due to the efforts of an Indian Chef named George Crum; and

WHEREAS: the average American eats nearly five pounds of potato chips each year; and

WHEREAS: the nation's potato chip manufacturers annually use more than three billion pounds of potatoes and employ thousands of persons in the production and distribution of their nutritious and tasty product; and

WHEREAS: the industry, through its trade association, Potato Chip Institute International, has worked diligently to improve the quality of its product;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of October, 1973 as

POTATO CHIP MONTH

in Minnesota.
