



# Proclamation

WHEREAS: in 1946 Torske Klubben chose to elect one of their peers, Roy Norman Thorshov, as "Boss"; and

WHEREAS: Roy Norman Thorshov has served Torske Klubben with such distinction he is still "Boss" after 27 years; and

WHEREAS: the dedication of Roy Norman Thorshov to preserving Minnesota's historic Norwegian heritage extends to other organizations: he is president of Nordmanns Forbundet and vice president of the Sons of Norway Foundation; and

WHEREAS: under the aegis of Roy Norman Thorshov, Torske Klubben continues to sponsor two graduate fellowships at the University of Minnesota each year; and

WHEREAS: Torske Klubben meets on the first Saturday of each month to relish the delicacy of torske washed down with Norwegian Minnesota plasma and topped with "liquid potato"; and

WHEREAS: the menu hasn't varied since 1933 and it is significant to note, since 1946, neither has the "Boss"; and

WHEREAS: these truths are self evident: that Torske Klubben members demonstrate admirable taste and remarkable tenacity; and

WHEREAS: Torske Klubben members are gathered here today, November 3, to observe their Fortieth Anniversary and to honor "Boss" Roy Norman Thorshov;
