Proclamation

WHEREAS: twenty-five years ago on November 6, 1948, WMMR, the student radio station at the University of Minnesota came into existence; and

WHEREAS: WMMR Radio was created as one of the first campus broadcasting stations in the United States, providing training for students interested in careers in broadcasting, journalism, engineering, business, and public relations; and

WHEREAS: WMMR has served for those twenty-five years as a creative outlet, providing training for students and a broadcast service to the dormitories of the University of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: WMMR and its alumni have won numerous awards for excellence in college broadcasting and many have achieved successful careers in broadcasting; and

WHEREAS: the State of Minnesota through the University of Minnesota is desirous of recognizing the achievements and training of students from WMMR radio;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Wednesday, November 7, 1973 as

WMMR DAY

in Minnesota and call upon all citizens to observe that day in the spirit of dedication to the goals of higher education expressed in the purposes and activities of WMMR Radio at the University of Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this thirtieth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-three and of the State the one hundred and fifteenth.
