



Proclamation

WHEREAS: American Reform Judaism this year celebrates its 100th Anniversary; and

WHEREAS: the Union of American Hebrew Congregations, the central body representing 715 Reform Jewish synagogues serving one million American Jews, will mark this American milestone at its General Assembly in New York City, November 9 to 13, 1973; and

WHEREAS: the ancient, yet modern, faith of Judaism has taken root and flourished in the free soil of American democracy and of religious liberty, drawing strength from and giving nurture to the ethical and spiritual foundations of American life;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim November 9 through 13, 1973 as

REFORM JUDAISM DAYS

in Minnesota, and ask that all citizens join in this wholehearted salute to our fellow citizens of Jewish faith as they launch a second century of vital and creative Jewish life in the United States.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this sixth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-three and of the State the one hundred and fifteenth.
