ORDINANCE NO. 3-1973
AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX
THE PROPERTY PRESENTLY
USED AS A MUNICIPAL
AIRPORT

WHEREAS, certain territory
described below is not pres-
ently included within the cor-
porate limits of any incorpo-
rated city, village or burroughs
and;

WHEREAS, this territory
borders upon the village limits
of the Village of Paynesville
and is presently owned by the
Village of Paynesville and is
deemed to be urban in charac-
ter; and

WHEREAS, the property in
now being used by the Village
of Paynesville as a Municipal
Airport;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Vil-
lage Council of the Village of
Paynesville ordains:

Section 1. TERRITORY AN-
NEXED. The corporate limits
of the Village of Paynesville,
Minnesota, are hereby extend-
ed to include the unincorporated
territory described as follows,
which territory is now and has
heretofore been adjacent to the
incorporated limits of the Vil-
lage of Paynesville and is pres-
ently owned by the Village of
Paynesville:

Beginning at a point on the
North quarter (1/4) of the South
One-half (1/2) of Section Six-
teen (16), in Township One
Hundred Twenty-two (122)
Range Thirty-two (32), 10000
feet West of the Eastern cor-
ner between Section Sixteen
(16) and Section Eighteen
(18) thence South no degrees and
21 minutes East 200 feet;
thence Southwesterly along an
1850 feet radius curve 50.7
feet to the South line of said
Section; thence West no degrees
and 7 minutes North 1000 feet;
thence 576 feet; thence North
no degrees and 21 minutes West
609 feet; thence North 43 de-
grees and 23 minutes West
1,129 feet; thence West no de-
grees and 25 minutes South
835.3 feet; thence North no
degrees and 5 minutes West
1117 feet; thence North 10
degrees East 500.3 feet to the
quarterline; thence East 80 de-
grees 25' North on the quar-
terline 1007.1 feet to the quar-
ter corner; and thence East 60
degrees 25' North 703 feet to
the point of beginning, contain-
ing 26.4 acres, more or less.

Section 2. DELAY. That the
said Clerk is hereby directed
to file certified copies of this
ordinance with the Secretary
of State, the County Auditor
and the Register of Deeds of
the county in which the terri-
tory is located and the Minne-
sota Municipal Council.
