AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO  
ANNEXATION OF PROPERTY.

The Village Council of the Village of Garrison does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. The following property situated in Section Twelve (12), Township Forty-four (44), Range Twenty-eight (28), is hereby annexed to, and made a part of, the Village of Garrison.
