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ORDINANCE NO.

An ordinance relating to the annexation of certain property of the Village of Kensington, Minnesota, and extending the corporate limits to encompass said land.

WHEREAS, Palmer J. Score and Lou Ann Score, his wife, and Melford P. Hagen and Ann M. Hagen, his wife, having filed a Petition indicating that they are the sole owners of the hereinafter described property lying and being in the County of Douglas, State of Minnesota; that said lands abuts upon the corporate limits of the Village of Kensington; and have Petitioned for the orderly annexation of said property to the Village of Kensington.

WHEREAS, the Petition thereof has been filed with the Minnesota Municipal Commission as Docket No. A-2499 "Kensington, Score, Hagen Annexation"; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Village of Kensington has examined said Petition, and finds that said property is so conditioned as property to be subject to municipal government; that the present pattern of physical development to the Village of Kensington necessarily provides for expansion and growth into the proposed annexed area; that the natural terrain and general topography makes such area amenable to orderly annexation; that the entire North boundary of said proposed annexation is contiguous to the southerly limits of the Village of Kensington; and that the annexation of said property would be for the best interests of the municipality, and of the territory to be effected and to be annexed.

NOW THEREFORE, the Village council of the Village of Kensington does ordain.

Section 1. That it is for the best interests of the municipality of the Village of Kensington and of the territory hereinafter described that said territory be annexed to and be made a part of the municipality of the Village of Kensington.

Section II. That the following described land, to-wit:

All that part of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-seven (27), Township One Hundred Twenty-seven (127) North, Range Forty (40) West, being described as follows: Beginning at the iron monument in the Northwest corner of Lot 3 of Hagen's First Addition to the Village of Kensington, Minnesota; thence North a distance of 400 feet; thence East and parallel to the North line of Hagen's First Addition to the Village of Kensington a distance of 158 feet; thence South a distance of 400 feet to the North line of Hagen's First Addition to the Village of Kensington; thence West along said line a distance of 158 feet to the point of beginning.

is hereby annexed to and made a part of the municipality of the Village of Kensington, and the corporate limits of the Village of Kensington shall be and are hereby extended to include and encompass the land and territory above described.

This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the laws of the State of Minnesota, and upon the approval of the State of Minnesota Municipal Commission; and upon filing a copy of the ordinance with the Municipal Commission, the clerk of Solem township, the Douglas County Auditor, and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.
