FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER

The above entitled matter came on for hearing before the Minnesota Municipal Commission pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 414, as amended, on January 2, 1974, at Bagley, Minnesota. The Village of Bagley appeared by and through E. H. Rasmussen, Attorney. The hearing was conducted by Howard L. Kaibel, Executive Secretary of the Minnesota Municipal Commission pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 414.01, Subd. 12. Also in attendance were County Commissioners Elmer Refshaw and Albert Gordon, Ex-Officio Members of the Commission. Testimony was heard and records and exhibits were received.

After due and careful consideration of all evidence, together with all records, files and proceedings, and being fully advised in the premises, the Minnesota Municipal Commission hereby makes and files the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Due, timely and adequate legal notice of the hearing was published, served and filed.

2. That the area proposed for annexation is approximately 320 acres.

3. That the area proposed to be annexed is characterized by residential development, commercial development, etc. or will experience development in the near future.

4. That the Village of Bagley does now provide to the area proposed for annexation the following services:

- a. Municipal electric service.
- b. Park and recreational areas.
- c. Village library service.
- d. Fire protection.
- e. Street maintenance.
- f. Police protection.

5. That the Village of Bagley is capable of and it is practical for it to provide to the area proposed for annexation the following municipal services within the next four years:

- a. All of the bove services set forth in Paragraph 4.
- b. Municipal water and sewer.
- c. Paved streets.
- 6. The population of the area proposed for annexation is 300.

CONCLUSIONS CF LAW

1. The Minnesota Municipal Commission duly acquired and now has jurisdiction of the within proceeding.

2. The area proposed for annexation is now or is about to become urban or suburban in nature.

3. The Village of Bagley is capable or providing the services required by the area described herein within a reasonable time.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property lying in the Township of Copley, County of Clearwater, State of Minnesota, be and the same hereby is annexed to the Village of Bagley the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof:

The West Half of the Northeast Quarter (W%NE%), the Northwest Quarter (NW%), and the North Half of the Southwest Quarter (N%SW%), all in Section Thirty (30), Township One Hundred Fortyseven (147) North, Range Thirty-seven (37) West, of the Fifth P.M.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the mill levy of the Village of Bagley on the property herein ordered annexed shall be increased in substantially equal proportion over a period of four years to equality with the mill love of the property clready within the Village. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the population of the Village of Bagley be and the same hereby is increased by 300 for all purposes until the next federal or state census.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the population of the Township of Copley be and the same hereby is decreased by 300 for all purposes until the next federal or state census.
