ORDINANCE NO. 121

AMENDMENT TO THE ORDINANCE ANNEXING PART OF THE SOUTH ONE-HALF ($s\frac{1}{2}$) OF SECTION THIRTEEN (13), TOWNSHIP ONE HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE (161) NORTH, RANGE FORTY-NINE (49) WEST.

The VILLAGE COUNCIL OF HALLOCK ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the following property shall be annexed pursuant to M. S. A. 414.033 to the Village of Hallock, Minnesota:

A tract of land which is part of the Southwest one-quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) and part of the West One-half ($W\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southeast One-quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirteen (13), Township One Hundred Sixty-one (161) North, Range Forty-nine (49) West bounded as follows:

Beginning at a point on the North line of said Southwest One-quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) which point lies 612 feet West of the Westerly right-of-way line of the Burlington Northern Railroad which point is also the intersection of said North line of the Southwest One-quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) and the Westerly line of Columbus Avenue extended;

thence from said point of beginning Southeasterly along a line parallel to said Westerly Burlington Northern right-of-way line to an intersection with the South line of said Section Thirteen (13); thence East along said Section line to an intersection with the centerline of Minnesota Trunk Highway #75; thence Northwesterly along said Highway centerline to the North line of said Southwest One-quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$); thence West along said North line to the point of beginning; containing 52 acres more or less.

Section 2. That it will be to the best interests of the Village of Hallock, Minnesota, and the Territory affected that such land be annexed to the Village of Hallock, Minnesota.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is for the purpose of amending the first line of the third paragraph of the legal description in Ordinance No. 120 to read: "Thence from said point of beginning Southeasterly along . . ."

Section 4. That said annexation shall be effective upon the publication of this Ordinance.

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING PART OF SOUTH ONE-HALF ($S\frac{1}{2}$) OF SECTION THIRTEEN (13), TOWNSHIP ONE HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE (161) NORTH, RANGE FORTY-NINE (49) WEST.

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF HALLOCK ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the following property shall be annexed pursuant to M.S.A. 414.033 to the Village of Hallock, Minnesota:

A tract of land which is part of the Southwest one-quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) and part of the West One-half ($W\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southeast One-quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirteen (13), Township One Hundred Sixty-one (161) North, Range Forty-nine (49) West bounded as follows:

Beginning at a point on the North line of said Southwest One-quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) which point lies 612 feet West of the Westerly right-of-way line of the Burlington Northern Railroad which point is also the intersection of said North line of the Southwest One-quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) and the Westerly line of Columbus Avenue extended;

thence from said point of beginning Southwesterly along a line parallel to said Westerly Burlington Northern right-of-way line to an intersection with the South line of said Section Thirteen (13); thence East along said Section line to an intersection with the centerline of Minnesota Trunk Highway #75; thence Northwesterly along said Highway centerline to the North line of said Southwest One-quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$); thence West along said North line to the point of beginning; containing 52 acres more or less.

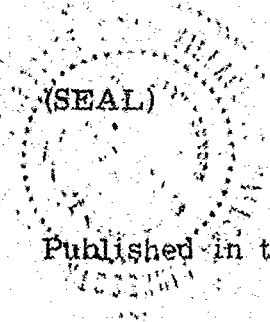
Section 2. That it will be to the best interests of the Village of Hallock, Minnesota, and the Territory affected that such
