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TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

The Minneapolis & St. Paul Suburban Railroad Company, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Minnesota, now owning and operating the street railway property within the Village of White Bear, State of Minnesota, hereby declares that it desires that each of the grants contained in the following, to-wit:

Ordinance No. 62 of the Village of White Bear entitled

"An ordinance authorizing 'The Minneapolis & St. Paul Suburban Railway Company' its successors and assigns, to build, equip, maintain and operate street railway lines along certain streets and avenues within the village limits of the Village of White Bear, Minnesota"

passed September 7, 1907, as the same has since been amended and now exists, which said grant is now owned by The Minneapolis & St. Paul Suburban Railroad Company"

and any other grant or grants from the Village of White Bear or any municipality under which said The Minneapolis & St. Paul Suburban Railroad Company now operates any street railway line or street railway property within said Village of White Bear, shall become an indeterminate permit under the provisions of Chapter 278, Laws of Minnesota for 1921 (Senate File No. 687), and consents that the terms of said Chapter 278 shall apply to and govern the ownership, control, management, maintenance and operation of the street railway property of said The Minneapolis & St. Paul Suburban Railroad Company.
