CONTRACT BOND

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS; That we, Reuben H Donnelley Corporation of Chicago, Illinois, (hereinafter called the Principal), and the AETNA CASUALTY & SURETY COMPANY, a corporation of Hartford Connecticut (hereinafter called the Surety) as Surety, are held and firmly bound to the State of Minnesota (hereinafter called the Obligee) in the sum of TWO THOUSAND AND NO/100ths (\$2000) DOLLARS for the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our successors and assigns, jointly and severally firmly by these presents.

THE CONDITION of the above obligation is such that whereas the Principal has entered into a contract dated December 18th, 1925, with the said obligee under which said contract said obligee is to furnish and deliver to said Principal by mail during 1926 one copy of all 1926 registration file cards as it comes from the ditto machine in the regular course of the registration procedure in the Motor Vehicle Department for which said copies of registration file cards the Principal agrees to pay weekly at the rate of \$4.00 per thousand names of Motor Vehicle owners thus furnished and in addition all postage charges on such shipments of copies, all of which conditions are more fully stated in said contract which is hereby referred to and to which this bond is or may be annexed.

NOW, THEREFORE, if the said Principal shall well and truly comply with all of its obligations to be done and performed by said Principal under said contract, including the payment of said amounts which shall become due to said State of Minnesota for such copies, then this obligation to be void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

THIS BOND shall only apply to the obligation of the Principal under said contract for the year 1926 unless it shall be continued in force for subsequent years by Continuation Certificate, in writing, executed by said Principal and Surety.
