

ORDINANCE NO. 79

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE DATE
OF THE REGULAR VILLAGE ELECTION

The Village Council of the Village of Carver, Carver County, Minnesota, does ordain:

SECTION 1. REPEAL.

All previous ordinances and regulations of this Village covering the subject matter of this ordinance shall be superseded upon the adoption of this ordinance, including ordinance number 65 as adopted on October 10, 1971.

SECTION 2. DATE FOR REGULAR VILLAGE ELECTION.

The date for holding the regular village election of the Village of Carver, Carver County, Minnesota, shall be hereby changed and hereafter shall be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in December of each year,

SECTION 3. NOTICE BY VILLAGE CLERK.


The village clerk shall immediately notify in writing the County Auditor of the County of Carver and the Secretary of the State of Minnesota of such change of election date, and cause this ordinance to be published.


SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.


This ordinance shall take effect and be of force from and after its passage and adoption and upon its publication.


