PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS, Axel Lindbloom was wantonly murdered in the town of Fall Lake in Lake County, in the month of July, 1920, and

WHEREAS, a warrant has been issued charging one Marion Butcher with the commission of said crime, and


WHEREAS, the peace officers of Lake County after diligent efforts have failed to apprehend said Marion Butcher, and

WHEREAS, public welfare demands that said Marion Butcher, or whoever is guilty of the murder of Axel Lindbloom, be apprehended and punished according to law.

NOW THEREFORE, I, J. A. O. Preus, Governor of the State of Minnesota, will cause to be paid out of the Treasury of the State of Minnesota, the sum of Five Hundred Dollars for the arrest and conviction, or for information leading to the arrest and conviction, of the murderer of said Axel Lindbloom.
