WHEREAS: a growing number of boys do not have the healthy, stimulating influence of a father to guide their youthful lives; and

WHEREAS: this deprivation can cause serious problems for the boys and consequently the community; and

WHEREAS: the Big Brother movement has been filling this void for almost seventy years by giving such boys the friendship they need through individual guidance and counseling;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim ^{WK} January 7 through January 13, 1974 to be

BIG BROTHER WEEK

in Minnesota, and furthermore, call upon all citizens to support the Big Brother Movement which is made up of many dedicated men.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this seventeenth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-three and of the State the one hundred and fifteenth.
