WHEREAS: Minnesota's pork industry is a major source of agriculture income to this state, and contributes substantially to the economy and welfare of Minnesota and this nation; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota's pork producers create thousands of pork industry related jobs for other Minnesotans; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota's pork production is a part of the third largest agriculture income segment of this nation's agricultural economy; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota's pork producers have dramatically improved the quality and healthfulness of pork today through untiring efforts in selection, breeding and management; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota's pork producers support their own organization on a county, state and national basis to further the image of their occupation and product; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota's pork producers are a part of a national effort to conduct further research for continued improvement of their product and industry; and

WHEREAS: in the public interest of this state and the entire pork industry, the pork producers of this state urge everyone to enjoy pork every day and especially during the week of January 20 - 26;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of January 20 - 26, 1974 as

and encourage all Minnesotans to assist and participate in this program to benefit not only a very important segment of our state's economy, but also for the good health and welfare of all of us.
