



Proclamation

WHEREAS: *the continued future progress of the State of Minnesota is, to a large extent, dependent on the total good health of its children and youth, the citizens of tomorrow; and*

WHEREAS: *total good health--physical and mental--can be achieved through good health habits learned early; and*

WHEREAS: *the Minnesota Dental Association and the Minnesota Department of Public Health maintain continuing educational programs in support of good dental health habits for young people and of fluoridation of public water supplies to prevent dental disease;*

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 3 through 9, 1974 as

CHILDREN'S DENTAL HEALTH WEEK

in Minnesota and urge that all citizens join in the observance.
