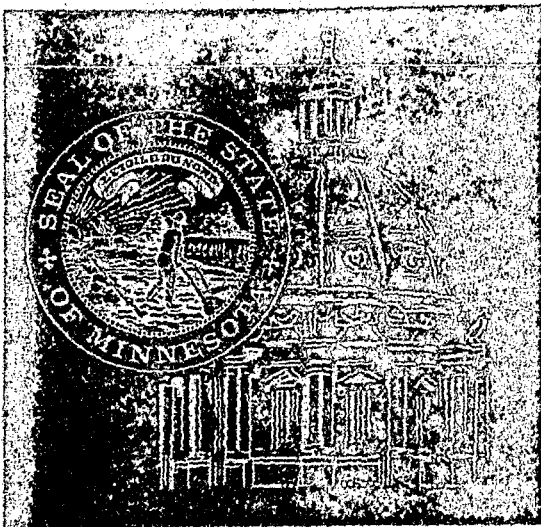




Proclamation
