WHEREAS: the Boy Scouts of America celebrates its 64th birthday; and

WHEREAS: the Boy Scouts of America is undertaking a nationwide effort to assist in overcoming the energy crisis; and

WHEREAS: over 100,000 religious, fraternal, civic, business, industrial, and veteran organizations have supported this move by the BSA; and

WHEREAS: scouting and its partners are contributing in this State's effort to conserve energy;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of February 1974 as

BOY SCOUT MONTH

in Minnesota. Further, on behalf of the people of the State of Minnesota, I wish to express to the Boy Scouts of America our deep appreciation for their efforts in promoting energy and environmental awareness in our communities.
