WHEREAS: minority business enterprises represent a very small but growing segment of our state's economy; and

WHEREAS: it is important to our economic and social health to increase the number of minority enterprises as well as the number of minorities they employ; and

WHEREAS: we wish to encourage all enterprises and all citizens of this state to assist in the development of minority business enterprises;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of March 24 - 30, 1974 to be

MINORITY BUSINESS ENTERPRISES WEEK

in Minnesota, and urge all elements of our economy to seek opportunities to contribute to the growth of minority business enterprises.
