



Proclamation

WHEREAS: Concordia College of Moorhead, Minnesota, will be the center for more than 650 participants from 14 State Community Colleges in the 1974 Minnesota Community College Fine Arts Festival; and

WHEREAS: the days of April 18 to 20 have been designated for the celebration of the festival, with concerts, art exhibits, theatre presentations, workshops, seminars and clinics, all of which are open to the community; and

WHEREAS: the Governor's Office of the State of Minnesota does enthusiastically support such activities, and commends the Community College System for its fine, ongoing program of educational involvement;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 18, 1974 as
