ORDINANCE NO. 33

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN REAL ESTATE DESCRIBED HEREIN

WHEREAS, a potition for the annexation of certain land described bereafter, was signed and filed by the sole owner thereof. Clarence Rusicks, with the Clerk of the Village of Silver Lake, on or about the 16th day of May, 1973; and,

WHEREAS, the petition for said annexation was filed and served upon the Minnesota Municipal Commission, Hale Township Board, and the McLeod County Board of Commissioners on or about May 15, 1973; and,

WHEREAS, nome of the aforementioned governmental bodies have submitted written objections to the annexation with the Commission; and,

WHERRAS, the Council of the Village of Silver Lake has made the determination that the annoration will be to the best interest of the municipality and the territory affected;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted that from this day forward the following described real estate be assented to the Villago of Silver Lake and be incorporated as a part of said Villago:

Beginning at a point 660 feet North and 679.2 feet West of the Southeast corner of Section 28, Township 117, North of Range 28 West; thouce South 477 feet to an Iron stake which is 33 feet North of the North right-of-way line of the Electric Short Line Railway Company; thence West on a line 33 feat North of said right-of-way line 547.9 feet to on iron stake; thence North parallel to the 477 feet line above described, 477 feet to an iron stake; thouse East 547.9 feet to place of beginning, except the following described property: Commencing at a point 660 feet North and 679.2 feat West of the Southeast corner of Section 28, Township 117, Range 28, thence South 477.0 feet parallel with the East line of said Section 28 to a point 33 feet North of the North right-of-way line of the Electric Short Line Railway Company; thence West 531.9 feat on a line perallel to said North right-of-way line to the point of beginning; thence continuing West 16 feet on the last described line; thence North 477.0 feet on a line parailel to the egid East line of said Section 28; thence East 320.0 feet on a line parallel to the said North right-of-way line of said Railway Company; thence South 185 feet on a line parallel to said East line of said Section 28; thence Southwesterly 350.35 feet to a point 117.0 feet North

a line parallel with the said sakt line of said Section 28 to the point of beginning together with an exceedent appurtenant to said shove described premises as more particularly described and set forth in that certain Warranty Doed recorded in the Office of the Register of Deeds in and for McLood County, Minnesota, in Book 43 of Deeds, page 39, now described as "Ruzicka's Addition".

SUBJECT:

[A-2049 Silver Lake, Minnesota] Ruzika Annexation

In 1973 the captioned proceeding was begun when a property owner outside the Village of Silver Lake filed a petition for annexation of its property with the village council pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 subd. 5 (1971). No objections were filed by the town board or the municipal council and the municipal council thereafter passed an ordinance annexing the territory affected. The council and the property owner now wish to rescind the petition and ordinance annexing the territory. According to the property owner's attorney, the ordinance was never filed with the Secretary of State or the Clerk. Minn. Stat. § 414.033 subd. 7 states that such an annexation is "final" upon filing a copy of the ordinance with the Commission, the town clerk, the county auditor, and the Secretary of State. I conclude that the annexation was not final if copies were never filed with the town clerk or the Secretary of State. The parties may rescind or withdraw the petition and ordinance. No action by the Municipal Commission is necessary in this regard.
