



Proclamation

WHEREAS: November is traditionally the "month of plenty" and is climaxed by the national celebration of Thanksgiving; and

WHEREAS: the feast of Thanksgiving, however, is not known to all Americans, nor to two-thirds of the world's population; and

WHEREAS: Meals for Millions, a non-governmental Foundation, is successfully utilizing free enterprise methods to help starving people throughout the world feed themselves on a self-sustaining basis; and

WHEREAS: this Foundation shows developing countries how to create, process and distribute their own high protein foods using their own raw materials, capital and manpower; and

WHEREAS: a widespread educational program has been initiated by Meals for Millions obtaining the assistance of civic, educational, medical and religious leaders within a community to encourage the use of the multi-purpose foods in schools, hospitals and orphanages as well as through normal commercial market channels; and

WHEREAS: Meals for Millions' educational program of self-help for the starving people of our globe is one of the finest agencies in the humanitarian task of alleviating hunger;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of November, 1973 as

MEALS FOR MILLIONS FOUNDATION MONTH

in Minnesota.
