An unsurveyed island located in the Northern portion of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 25, Township 63 North, Range 17 West, 4th P.M., containing approximately sixty-five hundredths (0.65) acre, more or less, lying about 1160 feet North 51 degrees 12 minutes West of a point on the Northeast corner of Lot 6 which point is located 135 feet North 9 degrees West of the N.C. on Southeast corner of Lot 6, Sec. 25-63-17.

You are allowed thirty (30) days from the receipt of this notice, within which to file in said General Land Office, any papers you may wish to submit tending to show cause, if any there be, why the said Island should not be surveyed and disposed of as public land of the United States.
