Proclamation

WHEREAS: for more than half a century Minnesota has been a leader in the life-saving School Safety Patrol program; and

WHEREAS: more than 35,000 young Minnesotans contribute their time and efforts to this program; and

WHEREAS: these young people, by their good and important work have earned the gratitude of all people of the State;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 17, through 23, 1974 as

SCHOOL SAFETY PATROL WEEK

in Minnesota, and do urge that all communities arrange special programs to pay tribute to the boys and girls who so faithfully serve the patrol program.
