WHEREAS: the Camp Fire Girls will be celebrating their 64th birthday on March 17, 1974; and

WHEREAS: as a national organization, Camp Fire offers young people throughout the country a program which combines group activity with the opportunity to develop individual talents. It offers a flexible program which encompasses the interest of youth from six to seventeen; and

WHEREAS: as a community organization, Camp Fire shares with others its concern for preserving the environment, adapting to social change and the application of democratic standards as well as its special concern of stimulating and guiding young people; and

WHEREAS: in Camp Fire Girls, recognition of accomplishments is combined with the encouragement to use developing skills to serve others in the community and State; and
