Proclamation

WHEREAS: the State of Minnesota is noted for providing "The Good Life; for its residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS: the State of Minnesota is continually reviewing its programs to help the mentally retarded of Minnesota find their share of the good life through training in the use of their limited abilities to the fullest extent of those abilities; and

WHEREAS: the people of Minnesota realize that the cost of training a mentally retarded person to do productive labor for wages is far less expensive than life-long institutional care; and

WHEREAS: there are many programs sponsored by private citizen organizations to aid the mentally retarded which are important adjuncts to the state's programs; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota Honey Sunday is sponsored by the Minnesota Jaycees to so aid the mentally retarded;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, April 21, 1974 to be

MINNESOTA HONEY SUNDAY

and urge the good people of Minnesota to support this and other programs in their state and in their communities to aid the mentally retarded.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this eleventh day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred seventy-four and of the State the one hundred and sixteenth.
