

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Ordinances of the City of Little Falls, Minnesota

ORDINANCE 796

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LITTLE FALLS TO IN-CLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORA-TED UNPLATTED LAND NOT EX-CEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS

ABUTTING UPCN THE CITY LIMITS WHEREAS, a certain petition dated May 21, 1973 requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the council on the 2nd day of July, 1973, and WHEREAS, the quantity of land em-braced within the area described is B8.5 acres more or less of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the lim-its of an incorporated city, village, or borough; and WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all owners; and WHEREAS, no objections to the an-nexation have been received from the fown board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the coun-aries of the land to be annexed; and WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the Coun-aries of the land to be annexed; and WHEREAS, the land described in the potient abuts upon the Coun-aries of the land to be annexed; and WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the Coun-aries of the land to be annexed; and WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the City limits at the northerly boundary thereof.

THE CITY OF LITTLE FALLS OR-DAINS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby de-termines (1) that the analysis of the best interests of the City and of the territory affected; (2) that the ter-ritory described herein abuts upon the City limits and (3) that none of said ter-ritory is now included within the limits of any city, village, or borough.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect seven (7) days after its publication. Infroduced this 4th day of March, 1974. Adopted this 18th day of March, 1974. Section 2. Territory Annexed. The cor-porate limits of the City are hereby ex-tended to include the unplatted land de-scribed as follows and the same is here-by annexed to and included within the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof: The territory to be annexed consists entirely of unplatted lands. All of these lands lie entirely within the County of Morrison, State of Minnesota, and the description of such lands is as follows:

All that part of Section 18, Town-ship 129, Range 29 West, not already in the corporate limits.

Section 3. Filing, The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Munic-ipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor.
