## Ordinances of the City of Little Falls, Minnesota

Ordinance 797
AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING
THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE
CITY OF LITTLE FALLS TO
INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED UNPLATTED LAND NOT
EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA
ABUTTING THE CITY LIMITS

ABUTTING THE CITY LIMITS

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated May 7, 1973 requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the council on the 14th day of May, 1973, and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is \$6.53 acres more or less of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or borought and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all owners; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, or the governing body or any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the City limits at the easterily boundary thereof.

THE CITY OF LITTLE FALLS OR. DAINS:
Section 1. The City Council hereby defermines (1) that the annoxation will be to the best interests of the City and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City limits and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village, or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to include the unplaited land described as follows and the same is fiereby annexed to and included within the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.
