ORDER FOR RETIREMENT

WHEREAS, the Honorable William G. Kreger, Judge of the County Court of Jackson County, State of Minnesota, has heretofore filed with the undersigned Governor of the State of Minnesota his written application for retirement, said application being made under and pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 490.12, and

WHEREAS, the said Judge William G. Kreger has submitted evidence that he has served as such judge, or as such judge and as such judge of a court of record, for more than 37 years,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, acting pursuant to the provisions of M.S. 490.12, do hereby order and direct the retirement of the Honorable William G. Kreger, to become effective at midnight on May 31, 1974. He shall become entitled thereafter to retirement compensation as provided under the law, and I further direct that this Order be filed in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.


