



Proclamation

- WHEREAS: there are more than 7100 children in the State of Minnesota who are living in foster homes due in part to overwhelming emotional or physical illness, alcoholism, poor housing, inadequate income, drug addiction, or family break-up; and
- WHEREAS: these children require a loving home, with foster parents who can cope with their special difficulties; and
- WHEREAS: foster children need understanding, a sense of security, a feeling of belonging and of being wanted; and
- WHEREAS: they need food, clothing, shelter, and medical care; and
- WHEREAS: foster children require what all other children need to grow into responsible adults;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, ratify the Bill of Rights for Foster Children and proclaim March 31 through April 6, 1974 as

in Minnesota
