


State of Minnesota



Proclamation

WHEREAS: some forty percent of the nation's air pollution comes from motor vehicles; and

WHEREAS: six out of ten are polluting excessively (and the most harmful pollution isn't visible as it leaves the tailpipe); and

WHEREAS: the problems causing pollution can be corrected, often with fairly simple engine adjustments; and

WHEREAS: individual motorist action now would cut pollution, save on fuel bills and help conserve our dwindling national fuel resources; and

WHEREAS: the Minnesota Automotive Industry Emissions Awareness Committee will conduct emission inspection lanes in the cause of cleaner air, commencing March 30 in Brooklyn Center;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April to be

NATIONAL CHECK YOUR VEHICLE EMISSIONS MONTH

in Minnesota, and call upon all Minnesotans to recognize the need for curbing exhaust pollutants from their motor vehicles by maintaining them in good working order.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twentieth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-four and of the State the one hundred and sixteenth.
