Proclamation

WHEREAS: the Teen Corps is an organization whose purpose is to involve young people directly in problem areas of our society; and

WHEREAS: the Teen Corps has contributed literally millions of dollars in goods and services since its inception in 1967 to the Appalachian mountain folk, the mentally retarded, pre-delinquent youngsters, and the State's Indian population; and

WHEREAS: all the funds utilized by Minnesota Teen Corps are raised by the public; and

WHEREAS: April 20, 1974 has been designated by Minnesota Teen Corps as "Trees of Hope" Day in Minnesota on which day students and adults from all areas of Minnesota will be gathering to work on environmental projects in their communities for the purpose of raising funds for the Teen Corps;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 20, 1974 to be

TREES OF HOPE DAY

in Minnesota in recognition of the achievements of this fine organization and encourage all residents to respond with moral and financial support.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this tenth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-four and of the State the one hundred and sixteenth.
