



Proclamation

WHEREAS: more than 200,000 Minnesotans live in mobile homes; and

WHEREAS: the State of Minnesota has become a major manufacturer of mobile homes for the Upper Midwest; and

WHEREAS: the mobile home industry is clearly an important segment of our life and economy in Minnesota constituting a free enterprise answer to non-subsidized low-income housing; and

WHEREAS: these good citizens comprise a section of all vocations, including students of higher learning, doctors, attorneys, executives, skilled and unskilled workers, and senior citizens;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 5 through 12, 1974 to be

MOBILE HOME WEEK '74

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to mark it well.
