NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 12 through May 18 as

OFFICE IMPROVEMENT WEEK

and call upon those professional societies, dedicated to better business management, to join with the Word Processing Association of Minnesota in bringing about an overall improvement in offices throughout the State of Minnesota in 1974.
