



Proclamation

WHEREAS: Traveler's Aid at Twin Cities International Airport has served air passengers for a decade and a half, providing 24-hour-a-day service, every day of the year, for the handicapped, the indigent, hospital patients, foreign nationals and other persons in distress; and

WHEREAS: Traveler's Aid helped 90,000 people of the more than seven million passengers who used the Twin Cities airport in 1973; and

WHEREAS: Traveler's Aid, a volunteer operation formerly funded by United Way, is in an emergency situation because of lack of funds, and there is no other service that could help the thousands of air passengers in need; and

WHEREAS: a blue ribbon committee comprised of labor and management members of Air Commerce, businessmen and private citizens has undertaken to keep Traveler's Aid alive, spearheading a \$60,000 fund drive; and

WHEREAS: Traveler's Aid benefit reception will be May 31 to begin this fund-raising program;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 31, 1974 to be

TRAVELER'S AID DAY

and urge all citizens of the Twin Cities to be mindful of the great contribution Traveler's Aid has made to the welfare of air passengers at the Twin Cities International Airport and give their moral and financial support.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this seventh day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-four and of the State the one hundred and sixteenth.
