



Proclamation

WHEREAS: school volunteers, at least one-half day each week, help children with reading, math, and other basic subjects on a one-to-one basis under the guidance of the classroom teacher; and

WHEREAS: school volunteers also help to organize and operate school libraries, make curriculum more relevant by introducing extra programs in social studies, creative drama, minority history, and creative writing; and

WHEREAS: school volunteers widen the horizons of the child by providing enrichment activities beyond those the school can provide, thus promoting a greater school-community involvement;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 21 - 27, 1974 as

SCHOOL VOLUNTEER RECOGNITION WEEK

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to honor the millions of volunteers who contribute their time, love, skills and special expertise to the educational process.
