

Proclamation

WHEREAS: the Israelis have welcomed, housed, and absorbed nearly a million and a half immigrants, most of them refugees from oppression; and

WHEREAS: they have reclaimed the desert, making it fruitful, creating industry, commerce, new cities, new harbors and modern communications; and

WHEREAS: in their dedication to providing a better life for all, they have made notable advances in the sciences, medicine, social welfare and the cultural arts, and have generously shared their knowledge with others, especially the new and developing nations of Africa and the East; and

WHEREAS: they have never forgotten that those ideals of justice, liberty and peace, which inspired generations of freedom-loving men, were first proclaimed by the prophets of Ancient Israel, and they have constantly sought to give these great concepts renewed significance by act and deed;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, May 5, 1974 to be

ISRAEL'S 26TH ANNIVERSARY DAY

in Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-third day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-four and of the State the one hundred and sixteenth.
