



Proclamation

WHEREAS: well over fifteen million people in the United States now enjoy the healthful recreation and sportsmanship of the game of Golf; and

WHEREAS: The Professional Golfers' Association of America will sponsor the Twenty-Second Annual National Golf Day on Monday, June 3, 1974; and

WHEREAS: during the last twenty-two years, over \$1,900,000 has been realized from National Golf Day for United Service Organizations, the American Red Cross, Caddie Scholarships, Funds, the U. S. Blind Golfers Association, the National Amputee Golf Association, the Jaycee War Memorial Fund, Golf facilities at Veterans' Hospitals and Military installations, Turf Research and Education, Golf Professional Education, financial assistance to those in straitened circumstances who have devoted their lives to Golf; and

WHEREAS: this day in 1974 will offer all the Golfers of America an opportunity to again assist many of these worthy charities and projects, as well as an opportunity to compete against the men's and ladies' PGA Champions and the USGA Open Champions;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Monday, June 3, 1974 as

NATIONAL GOLF DAY

in Minnesota and urge all the Golfers of our State to cooperate in this worthwhile venture by playing a round of Golf.
